This modification is in accordance with EXHIBIT E-Revised-7, Contractual Terms and Conditions, Section 14, entitled CHANGES, and adds the additional work detailed below:

Herzog will provide two (2) additional Rallway Workers-In-Charge (RWICs) according to the following Scope of Services and Pricing:

Scope of Services: Herzog shall provide two (2) Roadway Workers In-Charge (RWICs) for a combined work week of 80 hours, (a work week is defined as Sunday through Saturday). RWICs shall support multiple projects throughout the CMTA Central Corridor as determined by CMTA. Overtime shall not be considered until all 80 RWIC hours have been utilized and CMTA has preapproved overtime hours in writing.

Herzog shall support CMTA projects with RWICs to include the following tasks:

- Notify CMTA project representative immediately for any delay to the project, (for example, change/delay in train schedule, delay for hi-rail equipment, work window time, etc.).
- Provide supervision of personnel or equipment on, under, or over the railroad's tracks, structures, culverts, facilities, signals, and right-of-way (ROW).
- Support CMTA third party flagging needs.
- Any other activity that may impact rail services on CMTA property.

CMTA will schedule RWICs on a weekly basis. The RWICs shall be deployed as required to provide roadway worker protection and establish warning methods for the following:

- Notify personnel of the need to clear for trains/on-track equipment.
- Notify personnel when to occupy, clear, re-occupy the track and adjacent work area.
- Identify the place(s) of safety where personnel are assigned to go when clearing the track for traffic.
- Conduct job safety briefings to cover the aforementioned information.

RWICs shall confirm that each Roadway Worker has a valid Roadway Worker Protection card before work begins.

<u>Pricing:</u> Capital Metro accepts Herzog's detailed proposal dated September 20, 2017, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all pertinent purposes, for the Base Period 10/1/17-9/30/18 Pricing and the Option Period 1 10/1/18-9/30/19 Pricing, which is detailed below.
